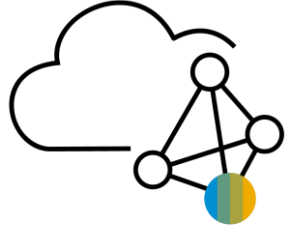

Integration with cXML

■ SAP Business Network language:



- The native language of SAP Business Network platform is **cXML**.
- cXML is an open standard created by SAP Ariba and the general specifications can be found on <http://cxml.org/>

■ Transport protocol:

- cXML is supported **ONLY** through **HTTPS** transport protocol.
- Suppliers must support **TLS version 1.2**

Suppliers can chose between 2 types of Authentication methods:

➤ HTTP Basic

- Via a username and a password



➤ Certificate based

- Only certificates issued by a trusted authority are possible (self-signed certificates are not supported).

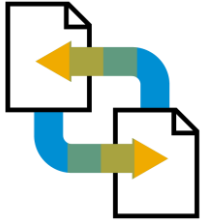

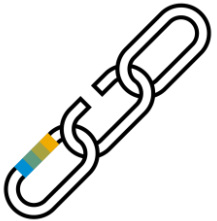
SAP Business Network - Integration with ANSI X12

- **SAP Business Network supports only AS2 transmissions inbound / outbound for ANSI X12 integrations.**



- Suppliers must support **TLS version 1.2**
- Only certificates issued by a trusted authority are possible (self-signed certificates are not supported).

- **Suppliers can chose between two types of Authentication methods:**





- **Basic Authentication**
 - Via a username and a password
- **Certificate Authentication**

Please note: certificates are also used for the signing and encryption of AS2 messages.

Frequently asked questions

Question	Answer
Is SAP Business Network “touching” the internal back-end system / middleware of the supplier ?	No it does not.
Is there a specific requirement coming from SAP Business Network for the supplier to use a specific ERP / ERP version ?	No. SAP Business Network does not have requirements or limitations related to the ERP / ERP version used by the supplier. That because the Supplier’s ERP / ERP version is basically not transparent to the SAP Business Network. As long as the supplier is able to process the files in the specification of NEMAK project and provide back files that comply with the NEMAK specification as requirements the actual back-end of the supplier is not transparent for the project.
Is SAP Business Network requiring the suppliers to use / purchase a specific middleware / third party provider in order to complete the seller integration ?	No. SAP Business Network does not have requirements or limitations related to the middleware / third party provider that the supplier is using. The suppliers are free to chose whatever integration solutions, applications, middleware's or service providers are better suited for their internal polices. As long as the supplier is able to process the files in the specification of NEMAK project and provide back files that comply with the NEMAK specification as requirements the actual middleware / third party provider of the supplier is not transparent for the project.
Is the SAP Business Network team, the SI team, part of the internal mappings that take place internally on Supplier’s side ?	No. Please note the SAP SI is not part of the internal mappings that take place on the supplier’s side. Please note that the SAP SI will not be in a position offer any type consultancy in terms or internal supplier mappings, supplier ERP processes, supplier middleware, etc. It will be the responsibility of the supplier to find and engage the necessary resources for their own internal project .

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
